Join the Boston Transportation Department for an update on our work to improve transportation safety in West of Washington Street.

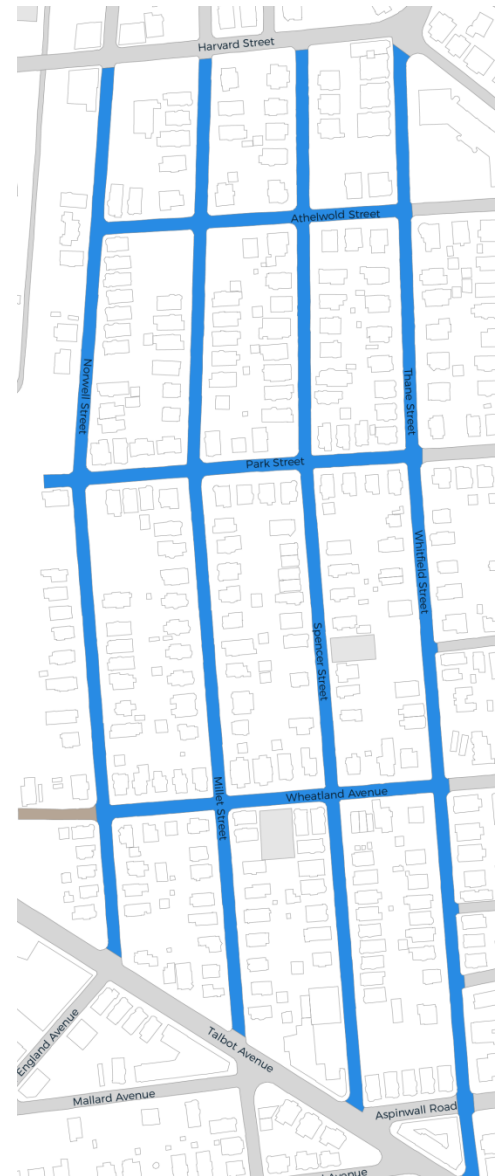
