**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND CANShare
FY2020 FUNDS, AWARDED BY Donor Group.**

WHEREAS, the Donor Group, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Office of Food Access; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000.00) would fund a match for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) through Donations in an amount Not to Exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00). CANShare donations will enable SNAP beneficiaries to double their buying power at Boston Farmers' Markets and select neighborhood convenience stores, providing greater access to fresh food. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the Donor Group, CANShare FY2020 award not to exceed the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000.00).
