AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY2019 DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction Program FUNDS, AWARDED BY National Institute of Justice.

WHEREAS, the National Institute of Justice, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (**\$248,500.00**) would fund two Criminalist positions, overtime, lab supplies, and continuing education expenses. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the National Institute of Justice, FY2019 DNA Capacity Enhancement and Backlog Reduction Program award not to exceed the amount of TWO HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (**\$248,500.00**).
