WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of THIRTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$13,520,000.00) would fund the continued support of unique planning, exercises, trainings and operational needs, that will assist in building enhanced and sustainable security capacities to help prevent, respond to and recover from threats or acts of terrorism, including chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive (CBRNE) incidents. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the United States Department of Homeland Security, and MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security' Urban Area Security Initiative FFY2019 award not to exceed the amount of THIRTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$13,520,000.00).
