

## PARKS DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES SOUTH END TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a public hearing on Thursday, January 2, at 10 a.m. on a request to remove eight public shade trees in the South End.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) in the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor Conference Room of the Boston Parks and Recreation Department at 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, Roxbury.

The request is for the removal of eight oak trees measuring between 4 and 5 inches dbh (diameter at breast height) due to construction of a multi-use 34-story high-rise at 252-258 Huntington Avenue in the Symphony area of the South End.

Public testimony will be taken at the hearing, or may be provided prior to the hearing in writing to the Tree Warden, Boston Parks and Recreation Department, 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Roxbury, MA 02118 or by emailing parks@boston.gov with "South End Tree Hearing" in the subject line.
