

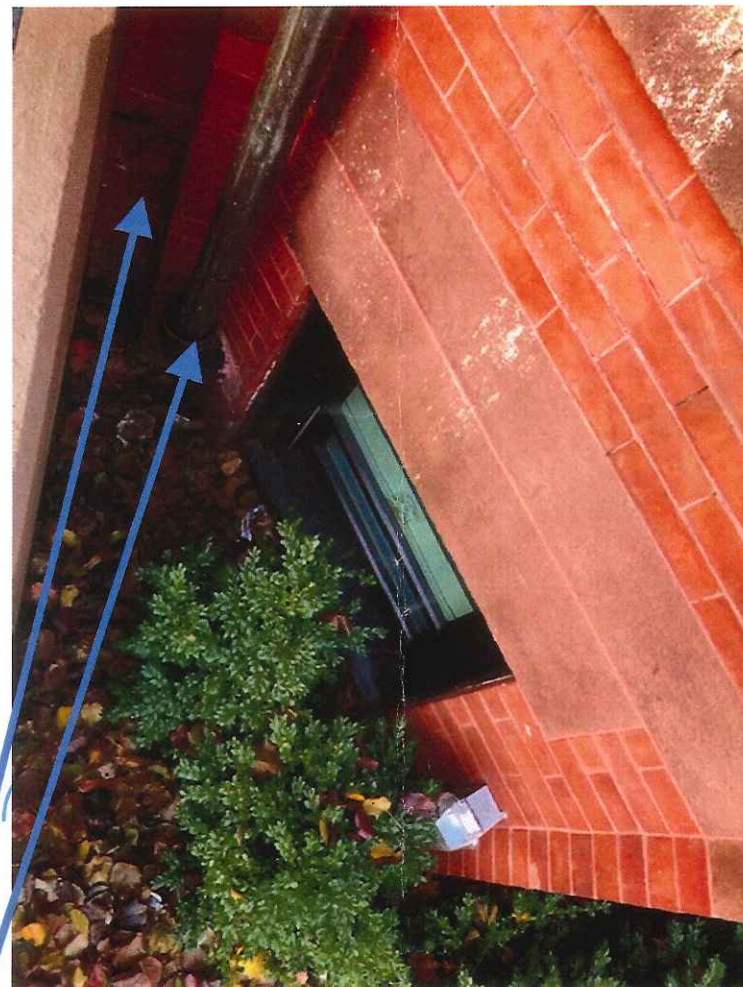
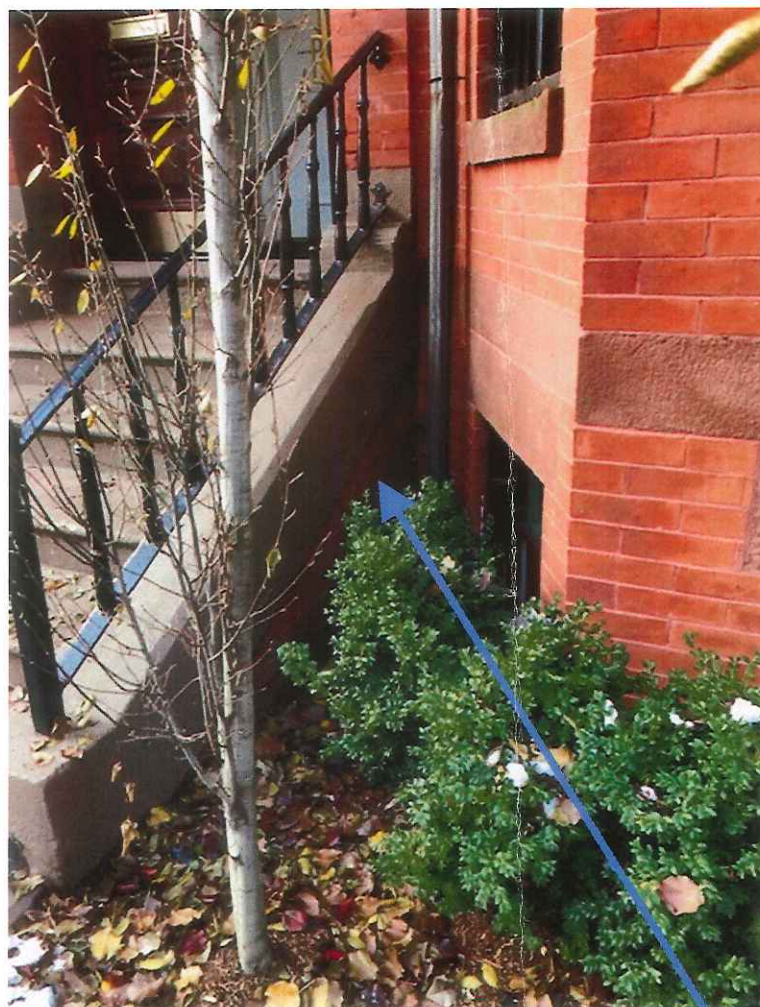

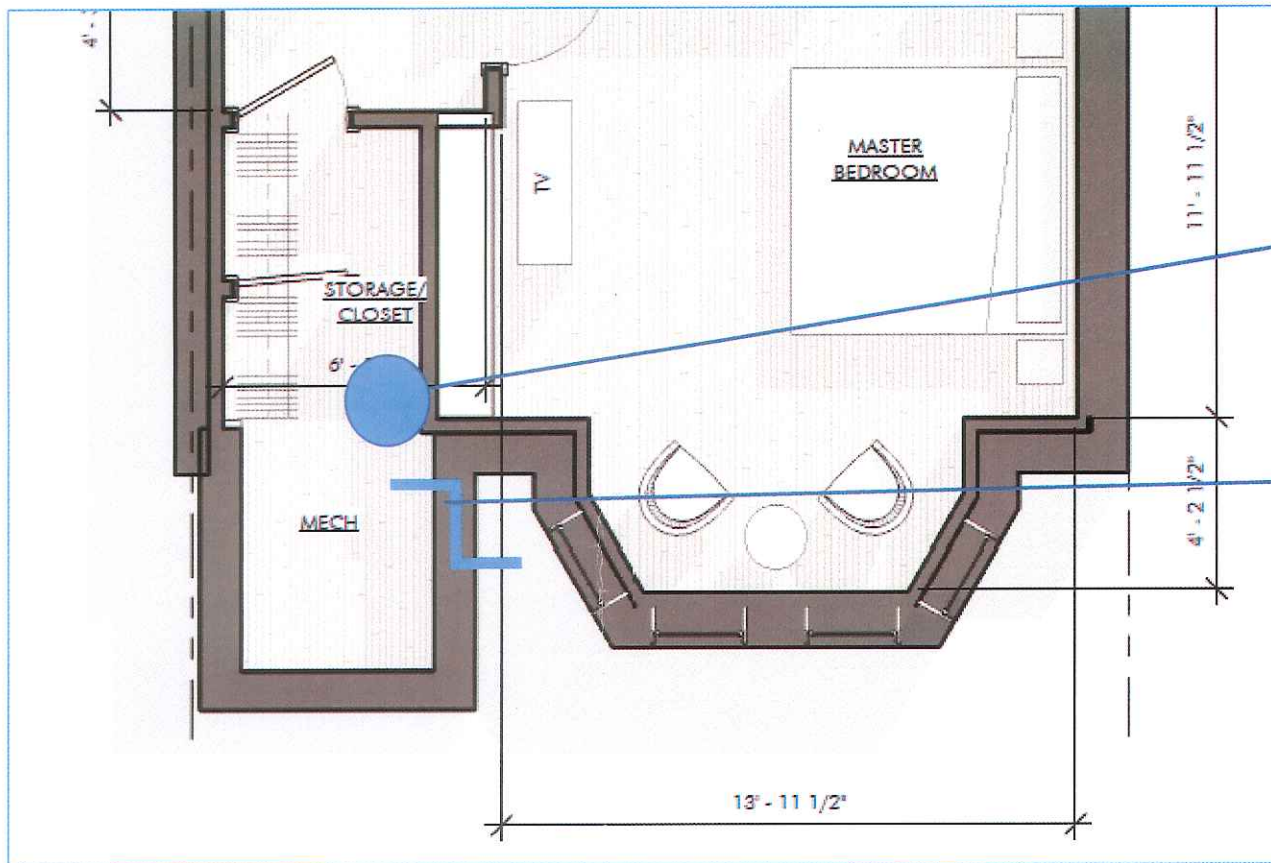
Existing Conditions- Front Stair area & Lower level with existing water heater

Proposed: Tankless water heater vent either on side of stair or on brick. Vent pipe would be either black iron or made to appear as black iron and mimic the adjoining spout: neighbors have down spouts that go into white PVC- but we would like to make this both aesthetically pleasing and historically pleasing, and make it unobtrusive. We have a large financial investment we would like to maintain and enhance.



Existing Electric Water Heater to be replaced

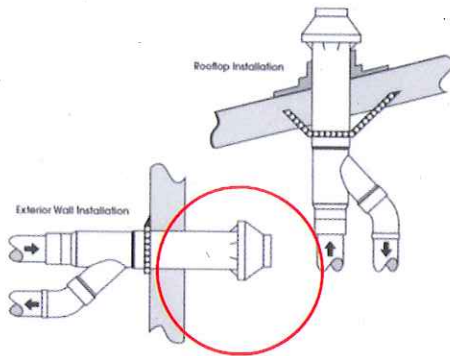
Venting, exact exit location needs to be determined by plumber
