The Boston City Council's Committee on Small Business & Workforce Development will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, May 27, 2020 at 10:00 AM.

The subject of the hearing is:

**Docket #0666, Order for hearing regarding the occupational presumption of COVID-19 exposure for essential frontline workers.** This matter was sponsored by Councilors Breadon and Flynn and was referred to the Committee on April 29, 2020.

NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum in attendance due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members attending this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.

**Attendance** In accordance with Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Executive Order modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law and relieving public bodies of certain requirements, including the requirement that public bodies conduct its meetings in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, the City Council will be conducting this hearing virtually. This enables the City Council to carry out its responsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations and ensuring public access to its deliberations through adequate, alternative means.
