Dear Councilors:

I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of THIRTY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND NINETY-ONE CENTS (\$30,722.91) in the form of a grant, Federal FY16 Innovations In Community Based Crime Reduction (formerly the Byrne Criminal Justice Innovation Grant), awarded by the United States Department Of Justice, passed through the BostonPublic Health Commission, to be administered by the Police Department.

The grant would fund the purchase and installation of video cameras in the Bowdoin/Geneva neighborhood, and also training police officers in Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND Federal FY16 Innovations In Community Based Crime Reduction (formerly the Byrne Criminal Justice Innovation Grant) FUNDS, AWARDED BY the United States Department Of Justice AND BostonPublic Health Commission.

WHEREAS, the United States Department Of Justice and BostonPublic Health Commission, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of THIRTY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND NINETY-ONE CENTS (\$30,722.91) would fund the purchase and installation of video cameras in the Bowdoin/Geneva neighborhood, and also training police officers in Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design. Therefore be it
