COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE - Virtual Hearing

August 3, 2020

The Boston City Council's Committee on Civil Rights will hold a public hearing on Friday, August 21, 2020 at 1:00 PM. This hearing will be held virtually via Zoom. The subject of the hearing is: **Docket #0795, order for a hearing regarding the epidemic of violence against transgender and gender non-conforming people.** This matter was sponsored by Councilor Elizabeth Breadon and Councilor Julia Mejia and was referred to the Committee on June 10, 2020. NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum participating due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members participating in this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.

Attendance In accordance with Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Executive Order modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law and relieving public bodies of certain requirements, including the requirement that public bodies conduct its meetings in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, the City Council will be conducting this hearing virtually. This enables the City Council to carry out its responsibilities while adhering to public health accommodations and ensuring public access to its deliberations through adequate, alternative means.
