I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIX DOLLARS (\$123,306.00) in the form of a grant, FY20 Reducing Injury and Death of Missing Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities, awarded by the United States Department Of Justice to be administered by the Police Department.

The grant would fund the purchase of SafetyNet tracking subscriptions for 225 families of individuals who have a tendency to wander due to dementia or developmental disabilities.

I urge your Honorable Body to adopt this Order so that the City of Boston may accept the funds expeditiously and expend them upon award for the purposes for which they are granted.

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY20 Reducing Injury and Death of Missing Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities FUNDS, AWARDED BY the United States Department Of Justice.

WHEREAS, the United States Department Of Justice, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIX DOLLARS (\$123,306.00) would fund the purchase of SafetyNet tracking subscriptions for 225 families of individuals who have a tendency to wander due to dementia or developmental disabilities. Therefore be it

ORDERED: that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the the United States Department Of Justice, FY20 Reducing Injury and Death of Missing Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities award not to exceed the amount of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIX DOLLARS (\$123,306.00).
