The subject of the hearing is:

***Docket #0179 Order for a hearing regarding ensuring all Boston Public Schools have a full-time mental health and social emotional support specialist.***

This matter was sponsored by Councilor Annissa Essaibi-George and was referred to the Committee on January 13 2021.
