- Operational reforms
 - Planning efforts
 - Operational audits
 - Departmental experience
 - Service and program demand changes
 - One-time investments must show ROI and implementation steps
- Savings proposals
 - TBD



New Initiatives

- New initiatives/investments
 - Analysis to show measurable progress toward specific goals
 - Priority for projects that:
 - Data show investment will have a significant positive impact relative to the investment;
 - Targeted at the vision of a thriving, healthy and innovative city;
 - Support the implementation of Imagine Boston 2030
 - Leverage other spending and resources



Revenue Proposals

- Revenue options
 - Estimates consistent with service levels in maintenance budget
 - Alternatives
 - Fees and fines that haven't risen, keep pace with inflation
 - Maximizing existing revenue streams



Capital Budget

- Addresses urgent needs while planning strategically for the city's future
- Facilities projects
 - Public Facilities Department feasibility site visits and data collection ongoing
- IT and Equipment projects
 - Submitted in August
