
Boston Trauma Response Team (BTRT)

- Work in partnership with NTTs on trauma response and recovery services
- Respond to individual and community needs after a traumatic incident.
 - Staff a 24 hotline
 - Immediate support to individuals and families impacted by community violence
 - Offer emotional support & stabilization services
 - Referrals = 135
 - Clients Served = 592


Description of Analysis


- Incidents in this analysis include;
 - A shooting with a single victim under the age of 18
 - A shooting with a single victim over 18
 - A shooting with multiple victims
 - A stabbing with multiple victims
 - A stabbing with a victim under the age of 18
 - Any gun related homicide
 - Any stabbing related homicide
 - Any incident that has an impact on the community as a whole (ex. Include a public suicide and the death of a child).
 - These incidents did not include stabbings of single victims.





- •5 Neighborhood Trauma Teams & 1 City-wide Boston Trauma Response Team
 - Received 139 incident notifications
 - Responded to 58% (81) of all incidents.
 - Of the notifications received, 68 met the criteria for activation (2, 4, 5)*
 - 65 incidents took place inside the catchment area of one of the NTTs (3, 4, or 5)*;
 - <u>38</u> incidents took place within the catchment area of one of the NTTs and met the criteria for activation (4 or 5).
