Inspectional Services Department Budget Questions

Councilor Kenzie Bok, Chair, asked:

- Can you provide an update on the short-term rental regulations and enforcement?
 - o How can the City address the "executive suite" loophole? I know we had discussed adding a more formal set of requirements for units to use the institutional affiliation exception; have we made any progress on this?
- What is the ISD formal process for approving after-hours and night-time construction work?
- We have recently been talking about preventing demolitions of buildings designated as pending landmarks; is this something ISD can do? Have you discussed it?
- I continue to hear about long delays for people getting permits; I know there were some bouts of COVID-19 that went through the department, but that was many months ago now. Are we adequately staffed to handle the permitting workload?

Councilor Liz Breadon asked:

- How many short-term rental violations has ISD issued?
 - o What kind of violations were these?
- Does ISD have enough resources and staff to do all that it is tasked with including enforcement?
- Does ISD have the capacity to enforce condo-conversion regulations?
- How can ISD educate residents to help mitigate rodent activity in our neighborhoods?

Councilor Ed Flynn asked:

- Does this budget include more funding to increase the number of ISD inspectors?
- How many building inspectors are there at ISD?
 - o How large of an area does each inspector cover?
 - o How many cases do inspectors have to report to each week?
- What measures is ISD implementing to address pest and rodent control?
- How long does it take once an application is filed through the ZBA to receive a hearing date?
- Will ZBA and abutters meetings remain virtual in the future?
