The Boston City Council's **Committee on Strong Women, Families & Communities** will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, June 10, 2021 at 10:00 AM.**

The subject of the hearing is:

Docket #0630, Message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Five Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$526,120.00) in the form of a grant, for the FFY21 Title III-E Caregiver Services, awarded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, passed through the MA executive Office of Elder Affairs, to be administered by the Age-Strong Commission. The grant will fund sub-grant for caregiver services to seniors, and grandparents raising grandchildren.

Docket #0651, Message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Nine Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Forty Dollars and Twenty-Five cents (\$936,440.25) in the form of a grant, for the FFY21 Nutrition Service Incentive Program, awarded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, passed through the MA executive Office of Elder Affairs, to be administered by the Age-Strong Commission. The grant will fund Incentives to serve more meals to elders.

Docket #0652, Message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Four Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Nine Dollars (\$486,609.00) in the form of a grant, for the FFY2022 State Allocations, awarded by the MA Executive Office of Elders Affairs, passed through the MA executive Office of Elder Affairs, to be administered by the Age-Strong Commission. The grant will fund the Elder Lunch Program in Boston.

These matters were sponsored by the Mayor and were referred to the Committee on May 5, 2021 and May 12, 2021.
