FY22 Projections

In FY22, we project 5 cohorts of the Childcare Entrepreneur Fund with **100 grantees** 

- **93** grantees at **\$3,500** each
- <sup>-</sup> **7** childcare cooperatives/start-ups at **\$7,000** each

As of June 2020, there were **485** licensed Family Childcares in the City of Boston, according to the MA Department of Early Education and Care. In the 2 years of the Childcare Entrepreneur Fund, we have trained **20%** of the Family Childcare owners in Boston. **In FY22, we will be able to train another 20%**.

By the end of FY21, the Childcare Entrepreneur Fund will have awarded \$346,500 in grants over two years. In FY22, we plan to award \$374,500 in grants.

An independent evaluation of the pilot program by UMass Boston found **positive changes in the participants' business practice confidence and leadership efficacy.**
