**RE: Request for Amended Order of Conditions (DEP File No. 006-1802 / BOS File No. 2021-033)
Neponset River Greenway: Tenean Beach to Morrissey Blvd
Boston, Massachusetts**

Dear Members of the Boston Conservation Commission,

On behalf of the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), BSC Group, Inc. (BSC) is submitting this request for an Amended Order of Conditions (OOC) for the extension of the Neponset River Greenway between Tenean Beach and Morrissey Boulevard in the Dorchester neighborhood of Boston, Massachusetts (the Project). The original OOC (DEP File No. 006-1802 / BOS File No. 2021-033) was issued by the Boston Conservation Commission on October 21, 2021 for constructing an approximately 3,620-foot long multi-use pathway, including a 10-foot by 670-foot pile-supported boardwalk, with a portion elevated over a small section of salt marsh and tidal flats in a cove within Dorchester Bay. All work as presented in the approved Notice of Intent application and as depicted in Neponset River Greenway, Victory Road, & Conley Street - Notice of Intent Plans (44 sheets; stamped 7/6/2021 by Kellan Lewis, P.E. BSC Group, Inc.) remains consistent and unchanged. However, DCR is requesting administrative review and official amendment of the Order of Conditions for the language included in Special Condition #46 regarding snow removal management.

Per Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection Policy for Amending an Order of Conditions (DWW 85-4 Revised March 1, 1995), the Department has determined an Amended OOC is appropriate and does not require a complete refile of the Notice of Intent when *“the changes sought in the Final Order of Conditions are relatively minor and will have unchanged or less impact on the interests protected by the Act”*.

All previously approved project-related activities and impacts to Salt Marsh, Coastal Beach (including Tidal Flats), Coastal Bank, Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage (LSCSF), 100-ft Buffer Zone to resource areas, and the locally-regulated Waterfront Area remain unchanged. The requested amendment centers on the language of Special Condition #46 and the requirement that a construction and post-construction snow management plan must be submitted and approved. In the only requested redline to the draft OOC, DCR suggested the replacement of SC #46 with the following language:

46. Snow removal shall be conducted in accordance with the DCR Winter Storm Plan (<https://www.mass.gov/service-details/dcr-winter-storm-plan-and-priority-map>). Snow will not be plowed or otherwise deposited into the waters of Boston Harbor or adjacent coastal beaches or banks within the project site. Deicing material and sand must be stored and contained in areas that will not allow for their migration into wetland resource areas. The snow management plan will be a perpetual maintenance condition that will not expire upon issuance of a Certificate of Compliance.

With this, DCR still complies with the intent to follow a winter storm plan and is in agreement, as state law already prohibits, to avoid depositing snow into Harbor and coastal beaches and bank and to avoid storing deicing material and sand in areas that could migrate to wetland resource areas. DCR also agrees to continue their established agency management plan and procedures in perpetuity. DCR is requesting relief from submitting a separate plan for Commission review and approval, stockpiling snow specifically where it will drain to catch basins, and removing all sand and salt from winter application on their facilities prior to April 1st as stated in the current, standing language of SC #46.

DCR submits that its plans and procedures need to remain uniform across its many parkways and facilities to ensure safe and proper implementation and understanding among site managers. Numerous special, site-specific conditions cannot be reasonably accommodated and are a substantial burden to operations. DCR notes that this condition cannot be lawfully applied under the local ordinance as it would have more than a negligible effect on agency operations as articulated by the state Supreme Judicial Court, and also under the wetlands regulations since the perpetual condition is not necessary for the project to meet the performance standards in accordance with 310 CMR 10.05(6)(b). Notwithstanding the jurisdictional limitations, DCR seeks to find common ground on the condition and requests that the Commission accept, as it has before, the reference to the DCR Winter Storm Plan as adequate compliance to the original intent of SC #46. DCR therefore requests the amendment of the OOC to reflect the language provided or requests SC #46 be removed entirely. As the federal funding for this project is available for a limited time, which would not accommodate further appeals or review, DCR seeks this compromise proposal to avoid the loss of the federal funds and preserve what is hopefully a shared goal for completing this worthy public project.

We respectfully request that you place this request on your next scheduled Conservation Commission Public Hearing. 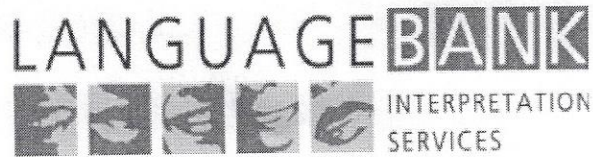

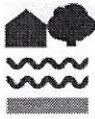
