



- Make decisions transparently.


GROUP EXPECTATIONS

- Share back to your communities about the project.


RECENT OUTREACH GOALS

GETTING THE WORD OUT

We:

- Sent a mailing to 5,838 addresses
- Announced via project email list, Office of Neighborhood Services newsletter, other projects and programs from the city, and on Twitter
- Posted 30 signs about the project through the neighborhood
- Flyered businesses
- Distributed materials at businesses, community locations, larger developments
- Asked you to share with your networks










RECEIVING FEEDBACK

We:

- Created a survey on Google forms in English and Spanish and distributed printed at Camden Lenox, received 49 responses
- Hosted 4 office hours (virtually) with the project team, no one attended
- Hosted 3 virtual workshops via Zoom, provided interpretation in Spanish, 9 people attended
- Attended summer events, received
 27 additional surveys






Goal: share with community members which locations rose to the top as priorities

Do these examples feel clear and relevant for Lower Roxbury?








We plan to send postcards and emails.





- We will create a design proposal


