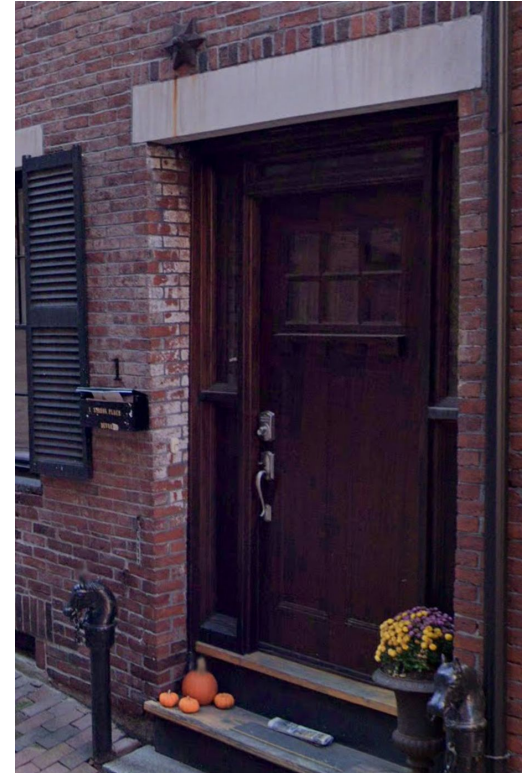
Basically, our neighbors spent 5+ years renovating their house to make it architecturally perfect, and we're going to copy them where it makes sense.

- Replace the shutters with black painted cedar similar in design to the house next to us.
- Replace the sills with precast granite.
- Replace the concrete basement well window with granite



# Paint things black

- The front door painted black
- The metal stars holding the walls together - paint it black



# Since we have a stonemason over, let's fix the missing curb

- We can restore the missing granite section from the curb
- [not visible from public way]  
We can replace the multicolor flagstone with brick or bluestone.



# Misc facade cleanup

- 6 cut wires have been dead since the pilgrims landed on plymouth rock. They can can safely be coiled and tied up on the building across the street removing the unnecessary overhanging cables.
- Let's be civilized! The black aluminum gutter need to be changed for copper.
