The Boston City Council's Committee on Public Safety and Criminal Justice will hold a public hearing on Monday, September 25, 2023 at 11:00 AM. This hearing will be in the Iannella Chamber, 5th Floor, Boston City Hall.

The subject of the hearing is:

Docket #1376, Message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in the form of a grant for Securing the Cities continuation grants, awarded by the United States Department of Homeland Security to be administered by the Police Department. The grant will fund continued enhancements for regional capabilities to detect, identify, report, and interdict nuclear and other radioactive materials out of regulatory control and provide regional training and exercise opportunities necessary to enhance capabilities, referred to the Committee on August 30, 2023, and sponsored by Mayor Wu.
