NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40A, Section 11, notice is hereby given that the Air Pollution Control Commission is proposing regulations pursuant to the Building Emissions Reduction and Disclosure Ordinance, Boston City Code, Ordinances, Section 7-2.2. The Boston Air Pollution Control Commission is proposing regulations to establish Hardship Compliance Plans, the Equitable Emissions Investment Fund, Fines & Enforcement, and other miscellaneous clarifying topics under the Building Emissions Reduction and Disclosure Ordinance (BERDO), as well as additional miscellaneous revisions to adopted regulations. The proposed regulations are available for review on the BERDO webpage at boston.gov/berdo-regulations.
