BON New Signage

Proposed Signage Details:

- Signage Text: BON!
- Signage Type: Wall-Mounted Sign
- Dimensions: Approximately 36 inches (width) x 18 inches (height) x 2 inches (depth)
- Installation Method: Securely fastened to the building facade with concealed stainless-steel mounting
- Materials Used for Sign Face: Durable aluminum panel with a matte powder-coated finish.
- Lettering: Raised acrylic or metal letters, painted with a satin finish for high visibility.
- Mounting Structure: Stainless steel brackets and fasteners, ensuring structural integrity and compliance with city safety codes.

Design Considerations:

- The signage will be proportionate to the building facade and will not obstruct architectural details.
- Materials and colors are chosen to complement the existing aesthetic of the district.

Compliance with Regulations:

- The proposed signage adheres to the Boston Landmarks Commission guidelines for materiality, color, and scale.
- The sign will be fabricated and installed by a licensed contractor, ensuring compliance with city zoning and signage codes.

Requested Changes:

- Change of Coffee Shop Sign to reflect "BON!" in White and Red
- Change of Shade from Green to Red
- Change of doorknob
- Adding New Visible Sign in Black and White (if permitted)
