Docket #1850, Order for a hearing to discuss the City of Boston's 2030 Climate Action Plan.

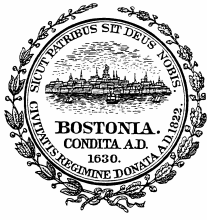
