## CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove eleven (11) public shade trees at **238 Saint Botolph Street, Boston.** 

The request is for the removal of eleven (11) Honeylocust trees, each measuring 5 inches DBH (diameter at breast height), in order to facilitate the construction of Northeastern University's new multi-purpose athletic and recreation complex.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) remotely on **Thursday, December 4, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. Via ZOOM.**
