NOTE: On a motion duly made and seconded, the June 25, 2025 meeting minutes for the Mayor's Office of Housing and July 2, 2025 meeting minutes for the Boston Public Library, following a roll call vote, were unanimously approved.

be and the same hereby is, transferred from the care, custody, management and control of the Boston Transportation Department to the care, custody, management and control of the Boston Planning Department.

The aforementioned transfer of land is authorized in the name and on behalf of the Commission, upon receipt of written authority from the Mayor.

NOTE: Brad Gerratt addressed the Commission and provided an overview of the project.

NOTE: Chair Craven asked “How much revenue is generated by the design?”

NOTE: Brad Gerratt noted “Most of the revenue comes from the loss of the garage and it’s close to nine million dollars.”

NOTE: Chair Craven asked “Does this create a budget hole for the City?”

NOTE: Brad Gerratt noted “In preparation for this transfer, we have worked closely with the Office of Budget Management, and the flow of funds will continue similar to how it is working now.”

NOTE: On a motion duly made by Commissioner Mammoli and seconded by Commissioner Wright, a roll call vote was conducted. Chair Craven: yes; Commissioner Wright: yes; and Commissioner Mammoli: abstained.


