Dear Executive Director Carvalho and Civilian Review Board Members:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your July 22, 2026 correspondence regarding the Civilian Review Board's determinations in CRB Complaint Nos. 293, 328, 359, 421, 570, and 610.

The Boston Police Department accepts the Civilian Review Board's Not Sustained findings in the following matters:

CRB #328, involving Police Officers Lawrence Li and Cesar Ortiz-Arias;

CRB #359, involving Detective Juan José Seoane López, as to the alleged violation of Rule 304 §6, Use of Non-Lethal Force; and

CRB #610, involving an unidentified Boston Police employee.

With respect to the matters in which the Civilian Review Board made Sustained findings, I will refer each case to the Internal Affairs Division for an independent administrative review. Those matters include:

CRB #293, involving Police Officer Patrick Gerard Fullam, Police Officer Sean C. Burke, and Detective David P. McMenamy;

CRB #359, involving Detective Juan José Seoane López, as to the alleged violation of Rule 102 §9, Respectful Treatment;

CRB #421, involving Detective Marc Delvalle; and

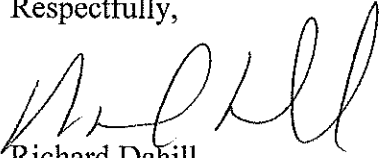
CRB #570, involving Detective John Nguyen.

As you are aware, the Department conducts an independent review of all allegations of employee misconduct. Any final determination regarding Department rule violations or discipline will be

made upon completion of the Department's administrative review and in accordance with applicable Department rules, collective bargaining agreements, and due process requirements.
