

MBTA announces public meetings highlighting investments to the Mattapan-Ashmont Trolley Line

Over the next two years the MBTA will invest approximately \$8m to replace propulsion and braking systems of the historic Presidential Conference Car (PCC) fleet. This significant investment will extend the service life of the PCC fleet in the near term and into the next decade. Three public meetings will be held to seek public comment, highlight the investments and discuss a study currently underway which will assess existing conditions of the corridor's infrastructure and future needs beyond the useful service life of existing assets.
