TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I transmit herewith for your approval a supplemental appropriation order for \$7,746,300 to provide funding in the Police Department to cover the FY17 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the City of Boston and the Boston Patrolmen's Association. The terms of the contracts are July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 and July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020. The major provisions of the contracts include base wage increases of 2% effective the first pay period of July of each fiscal year. The agreements also include increases to existing Quinn Bill/Education benefits, modified steps beginning in July 2016, and increases to hazardous duty pay beginning in July 2017.

This appropriation order will be supported by available revenue from Building Permits.

I respectfully request your support of this supplemental appropriation.


