NEVERTHELESS MOST OF YOU ATTENDED THE HEARING, SPENLTS SOME TIME AT THE HEARING AND THEN COUNCILORS CAME BY TO OBSERVE THE HEARING AS WELL BECAUSE I KNOW THIS IS AN ISSUE EVERYONE HERE FEELS VERY VERY STRONGLY B WE DIDN'T TAKE ACTION OBVIOUSLY.

WE HAVE NO ACTIONABLE ITEMS TO TAKE AT THIS POINT BUT I'M

REINTRODUCING IT TODAY SO WE CAN CONTINUE THIS CONVERSATION. THE HEARING WITH A HELD IN DECEMBER OF LAST YEAR WAS INCREDIBLY INSIGHTFUL AND I WANTED TO THANK FOLKS FROM THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT -- THE ENERGY COALITION WHICH IS THE DRIVING FORCE BEHIND THIS. AND BOSTON MEDICAL CENTER. BMC HAS COMMITTED AND THEY ARE ON, THEY WILL ACHIEVE THIS GOAL OF BEING CARBON NEUTRAL BY THE END OF 2018.

THIS STRIKING UNION WORKERS, THEIR MOTTO WAS SOLIDARITY. WE ALSO SHARE THAT SAME SOLIDARITY WITH THE STRIKING WORKERS TODAY.

I WOULD BE REMISS IF I DID NOT MENTION THAT I HAVE ALSO SEEN THE SPIRIT OF THESE WORKING PEOPLE AND THE MANY DEDICATED PUBLIC SERVICE EMPLOYEES AND FIRST RESPONDERS RIGHT HERE IN BOSTON.

THEY DO THEIR BEST, OFTENTIMES IN VERY DIFFICULT SITUATIONS, TO DELIVER BASIC CITY SERVICES TO HELP MAKE LIFE BETTER FOR THE RESIDENTS OF BOSTON.

I HAD A CHANCE TO WORK CLOSELY WITH BOSTON POLICE OFFICERS AT THE PROBATION OFFICE ACROSS THE STREET AT SUFFOLK SUPERIOR COURT.

I CAN'T BEGIN TO TELL YOU HOW MUCH -- HOW MOVING IT IS TO HEAR THESE STORIES ABOUT OUR PROFESSIONAL E.M.T.s RUSHING TO THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT, TRANSPORTING PEOPLE TO THE HOSPITAL.
