**WHEREAS**, the the United States Department Of Justice and MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, are being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$115,000.00) would fund one full-time BPD Civilian Domestic Violence Advocate position and a portion of another. Therefore be it

**ORDERED:** that the Mayor, acting on behalf of the City of Boston be, and hereby is authorized, pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend the the United States Department Of Justice, and MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security' FFY.17 Violence Against Women Act STOP grant award not to exceed the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$115,000.00).
