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>> GOOD AFTERNOON, LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, WELCOME TO THE IANELLI CHAMBER ABOUT. MY NAME IS MATT O'MALLEY MALLEY. CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE FOR HEALTHY WOMEN AND FAMILIES, VARIOUS GRANTS THAT WE WILL HEAR ABOUT IN GREAT DETAIL THAT WILL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE FOOD ACCESS. COMMISSIONER I LOVE THE NEW NAME. AND THE OFFICE OF IMMIGRANT ADVANCEMENT. **BEFORE WE GET INTO THE** SPECIFICS. THIS WILL BE SIX GRANTS, WE'LL BE DISCUSSING THEM ALL TOGETHER BUT WE'LL DO THEM OBVIOUSLY NUMERICALLY. IF YOU COULD INTRODUCE YOUR NAME AND YOUR TITLE BEFORE WE GET INTO THE SPECIFICS AND WELCOME. >> GOOD AFTERNOON, MR. CHAIRMAN, MY NAME IS KATARINA LOPEZ, DIRECTOR OF THE MAYOR'S COMMITTEE FOR FOOD ACCESS. >> MARIA SHAE. >> AGNES CHANNING, CHIEF OF STAFF FOR THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF IMMIGRANT ADVANCEMENT. >> WE'RE JOINED BY MY FELLOW COUNSELOR ED FLYNN. WELCOME, COWNG LEGISLATOR. >> PERFECT, THANK YOU, THAT'S WHY YOU'RE MY FAVORITE COLLEAGUE. FIRST WE'LL START WITH MS. LOPEZ ON DOCKET 0109, WHICH IS \$280,000 FOR DOUBLE UP FOOD BUCKS PROGRAM AWARDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE. COULD YOU TALK A LITTLE BIT THAT **GRANTS**? >> YES, MR. CHAIRMAN. WE GOT A GRANT FOR \$280,000, BOSTON DOUBLE UP PROGRAM, IN LOW INCOME COMMUNITIES IN THE INTOF AND WE ARE PREMIERING THE PROGRAMS IN DORCHESTER AND MATTAPAN.

EVERY TIME A USER GOES TO A CORNER STORE, THAT USE PART OF THE HOUR PROGRAM, WE MATCH \$1 TO \$1 TO ALL OF THE SNAP USERS THAT BUY FRUIT AND VEGETABLES. PART OF THE MENINO IS GOING TO BE USED FOR EVALUATION FOR THE THREE YEARS OF THE PROGRAM AND THAT WILL BE \$47,000 OF THAT TOTAL AMOUNT. AND WE HAVE \$26,000 DESIGNED FOR HELP TO THE STORES, TO MAKE BETTER STORES. THAT NEED A BETTER REFRIGERATOR, IF THEY NEED BETTER SIGNAGES WE HELP THEM TO DO THAT. AND WE ALSO HAVE \$25,000 ASSIGNED FOR OUTREACH IN THAT LOCATION. >> SO THIS IS \$283,000 IN SUM TOTAL? >> 292,000. I'M SORRY, \$282,000. >> WE WERE RESIGNING UP. \$282,000, OF THAT \$150,000 WILL BE MATCHED DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR. SO IF I AM CURRENTLY **RECEIVING -- USE SNAP TO** PURCHASE GROCERIES, MY BUYING POWER WILL BE DOUBLED UP TO -->> UP TO \$10 A DAY. >> I'M SORRY? >> \$10 A DAY. YOU CAN GO TO A COORDINATED STOOR, YOU WILL BE CHARGED \$5 AND WE WILL BE ROIDING THE OTHER \$5. AND YOU CAN DO THIS EVERY DAY. >> 365 DAYS A YEAR. THAT'S FANTASTIC. IS THIS JUST IN BOSTON OR THE **REST OF THE COMMONWEALTH?** >> IN MASSACHUSETTS WE ARE THE PILOT PROGRAM. >> OF THE 282, 150K, 40,000 IS FOR EVALUATION, WHAT DOES THAT MEAN? IS THAT STAFF COSTS? >> WE ARE PARTNERING WITH TUFTS UNIVERSITY. SO THAT WE WANT TO KNOW IF THIS MAPPING PROGRAM ACTUALLY CHANGE THE BEHAVIOR AND THE HEALTH OF THE COMMUNITIES. AND THEY ARE DOING SURVEYS AT

THE STORE, DOING SURVEYS WITH THE CUSTOMERS. WE ALSO WANT TO EVALUATE THAT TOO. ACCESS THIS PROGRAM AT THE CORNER STORES AND IMPROVE THE **BUSINESSES, BRING MORE CONSUMERS** TO THE STORES. >> THAT'S GREAT. THAT'S GREAT. SO THAT SORT OF SUPPORT OF THE PROGRAM IN METRICS OF THE PROGRAM TO HOPEFULLY GROW IT, THE NEXT \$26,000 WOULD BE DIRECT ASSISTANCE TO THE STORES, SIGN AN. REFRIGERATION. >> GO TO THE STORES, THEY SAY LIKE THEY NEED BETTER ACCOUNTING. TO MAKE SURE WE TRACK EVERYTHING WELL. WE WILL PROVIDE SOME FUNDS TO IMPROVE THOSE. >> THAT'S GREAT. AND YOU'RE LOOPING IN THE AMERICAN STRENGTHS DIRECTORS AS WELL? >> WE ARE WORKING -- YES, THE PERSON WHO IS OUR CONTACT, WORKING WITH THE SMALL **BUSINESSES**. >> FANTASTIC. AND THE REMAINING \$25,000 WILL **BE GENERAL OUTREACH?** >> TO THE COMMUNITIES TO KNOW WHERE TO BUY, ALSO TO INCREASE THEIR STIGMA, BETTER FOR THE SNAP USERS TO BE THERE AND TO INCENTIVIZE THEM TO USE THE SNAP DOLLARS AT THE CORNER STORES. >> IF I'M A SNAP RECIPIENT IS THERE 96 I HAVE TO DO TO OPT IN THIS PROGRAM. OR JUST WHEN I GO IT WILL BE LIKE SAVING MONEY? >> WE ARE TRYING TO REMOVE ALL THE BARRIERS THE SNAP USERS HAVE. YOU GO WITH YOUR SNAP CARD AND DO YOUR SHOPPING. >> I LIKE THAT, DO YOU HAVE ANY **QUESTIONS FOR MS. LOPEZ?** COUNSELOR FLYNN. >> I DON'T HAVE ANY QUESTIONS. I JUST WANT TO SAY THANK YOU FOR EXCELLENT WORK YOU ARE DOING

WITH THE CITY, REPRESENTING THE CITY WELL BUT PROVIDING INVALUABLE SERVICES TO SO MANY PEOPLE THAT NEED OUR ASSISTANCE. SO I JUST WANT TO SAY THANK YOU TO YOU AND YOUR ACHIEVEMENT AS WELL FOR PROVIDING COMPASSIONATE ASSISTANCE TO THE MOST NEEDY IN SOCIETY. SO THANK YOU. >> THANK YOU, COUNSELOR FLYNN. >> I DON'T HAVE ANY OTHER OUESTIONS. THAT SEEMS PRETTY STRAIGHTFORWARD. THIS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN EVERY NEIGHBORHOOD I GUESS IS MY NEXT **QUESTION**? >> WE HAVE IN THE HIGH NEEDS NEIGHBORHOOD FOR NOW. >> OKAY SO WHICH NEIGHBORHOODS ARE THOSE? >> THEY ARE MATTAPAN, DORCHESTER AND ROXBURY BECAUSE THEY HAVE A HIGH FOOD INSECURITY RATE IN THE CITY OF BOSTON. WE ARE HONING WE CAN GROW THESE IN OTHER NEIGHBORHOODS BUD NOW. OUR FOCUS AWARD ARE IN THOSE THREE. >> MAKE SURE I GET THIS RIGHTS. THE MONEY IS CONNECTED WITH THE CARD OR WITH THE STORE? >> WITH THE STORE. >> IF YOU LIVE IN ANOTHER NEIGHBORHOOD AND YOU GO TO ONE OF THESE STORES IN MATTAPAN DORCHESTER OR ROXBURY YOU CAN ACCESS IT. >> YES. >> ONLY ALLOWS US TO START SMALLER. THAT'S ALL I HAVE FOR NOW, THANK YOU VERY MUCH. MIRVEL DO I HAVE TO -- MICHELLE DO I HAVE TO GAVEL OUT OF EVERY -- THANK YOU VERY MUCH. EMILY SHAY TO DISCUSS DOCKETS 0110, '01 27, '01 20, AND 0125. AUTHORING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND DEPEND THE AMOUNT OF \$213,000. FOR TITLE 3 OMBUDSMAN 2019 FUNDS AWARDED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT

OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, PASSED THROUGH MASS DEPARTMENT OF ELDERLY AFFAIRS, TO BE ADMINISTERED BY AGE SMART BOSTON. DO I HAVE THAT RIGHT? >> SURE. >> TELL US ABOUT IT. >> ALL FOUR OF THESE DOCKETS TODAY ARE REGULAR FUNDING THAT WE GET IN EVERY YEAR THAT WE ARE COMING HERE TO ASK PERMISSION TO USE. THE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM IS A **PROGRAM THAT -- WHERE THERE ARE** VOLUNTEERS. THAT ARE RECRUITED AND TRAINED TO PROVIDE SUPPORT TO PEOPLE IN NURSING HOMES. IF RESIDENTS OF NURSING HOMES ARE HAVING ANY TROUBLES, THEY CAN HELP THESE TO PREVENT THESE TO A RISE, WE THEN PUT THE PROGRAM OUT TO BID. AND OUR LONG STANDING PARTNER IN THIS PROGRAM IS ETHOS WHO OPERATES THE PROGRAM FOR CITY OF BOSTON. SO THAT IS WHAT THE REQUEST IS, FOR THAT \$214,000 NUMBER, INCLUDES OUR LAST YEAR AMOUNT, PLUS A BUFFER OF 25% IN CASE WE GET AN INCREASE FROM THE STATE. THE WAY THIS FUNDING WORKS IS WE GET A PRELIMINARY PLANNING AMOUNT AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR. AND THEN WE GET A FINAL ALLOCATION AMOUNT, SOMETIME DURING THE END OF THE YEAR. SO NUMBERS CAN CHANGE FROM THE BEGINNING TO THE END. THE OTHER PIECE THAT CHANGES NUMBERS FOR OUR OLDER AMERICANS ACT DOLLARS THAT SOMETIMES WE HAVE CARRYOVER DOLLARS AND THAT TAKES A WHILE TO GET APPROVED BY THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF ELDER AFFAIRS. SO THAT COMES IN TOWARDS END OF THE YEAR, AS WELL. >> OKAY, SO THIS WOULD FUND A SALARY? >> SO WHAT HAPPENS IS THAT WE WOULD PUT IT OUT TO BID.

WE WOULD PUT IT OUT TO BIT. ETHOS WON THE BID. ACTUALLY YOU HAVE TO BE CERTIFIED TO BE AN OMBUDSMAN. THEY'RE THE ONLY ONE CERTIFIED IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO RUN THAT PROGRAM. >> THEY ADMINISTER THE GRANT, MEANING THEY GO THROUGH THE **PROCUREMENT PROGRAM?** >> THEY ARE RUNNING THE PROGRAM. >> DID ANYONE ELSE APPLY LAST TIME? >> NO, NO ONE ELSE APPLIED LAST TIME. OF ALL THE GRANTS WE PUT OUT TO BID THIS ONE IS VERY SPECIALIZED AND YOU KIND OF HAVE TO HAVE A CERTIFICATION WITH THE STATE IN ORDER TO RUN THE PROGRAM. >> AND ETHOS DOES A FANTASTIC JOB, SERVES PEOPLE ALL ACROSS THE CITY. WE'RE PROUD OF THEIR WORK. >> WHAT HAPPENS IS ETHOS THEN SUBMITS TO US AS THE FUNDER A SCOPE OF SERVICES SAYING THIS IS EXACTLY WHAT WE'RE GOING TO DO IN THE BUDGET WHICH WE THEN APPROVE AND THEN WE MONITOR THE PROGRAM ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO MAKE SURE THAT THINGS ARE GOING WELL. >> THAT'S GREAT. HOW LONG HAS THIS PARTNERSHIP WITH ETHOS GONE ON THEN? >> A LONG TIME. >> PROBABLY PREDATES US -->> PROBABLY 30 YEARS. >> WE'RE GRATEFUL FOR DALE, WHO WILL BE RETIRING SOON, HE WILL BE MISSED, A GREAT PARTNER FOR THIS CITY. >> I SHOULD SAY THIS MONEY IS ALL PASSED THROUGH TO US. >> >> GREAT, I HAVE NO MORE OUESTIONS FOR DOCKET 0110. COUNSELOR FLYNN. >> THANK YOU FOR BEING HERE AND FOR YOUR WORK AND JURY STAFF'S WORK FOR SO MANY YEARS, PROVIDING OUR ELDERLY OUR SENIORS WITH THE RESPECT AND

DIGNITY THAT THEY'VE EARNED. I'VE ALWAYS HAD GREAT RESPECT FOR THIS DEPARTMENT, I'VE FOLLOWED IT CLOSELY FOR PERHAPS 30 OR 40 YEARS AND I'VE SEEN EXCELLENT COMMISSIONERS OVER THE YEARS AND COMMISSIONER I THINK YOU'RE ONE OF THE BEST WE'VE EVER HAD, THE WAY YOU TREAT PEOPLE AND THE WAY YOU TREAT OUR ELDERLY. I JUST WANT TO SAY, THANK YOU FOR YOUR OUTSTANDING WORK, AND CONTINUE WORKING HARD FOR THE SENIORS OF BOSTON SO WE'RE PROUD OF YOU. >> THANK YOU, COUNCILOR, I APPRECIATE THAT. >> I WOULD SERK THAT EMOTION, COMMISSIONER, I HAVE ONLY A COUPLE OF MONTHS LONGER THAN YOU WORKING HERE BUT YOU'VE BEEN A TERRIFIC PARTNER, ONE OF THE FINEST COMMISSIONERS WE HAVE. WE'RE NOT DONE WITH YOU YET. THREE MORE. 0317, AUTHORIZING BOSTON TO EXPEND THE AMOUNT OF \$1,846,000. FROM THE COUNCIL ON AGING FORMULA GRANT PROGRAM, TO BE ADMINISTERED BY AGES STRONG, THE AGE STRONG COMMISSION. CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT DOCKET 0217 PLEASE. >> WE HAVE THE DESIGNATION OF **BEING THE COUNCIL ON AGING, 350 OUT OF 351 TOWNS ACROSS THE** STATE HAVE A COUNCIL ON AGING. >> WHICH TOWN DOESN'T? >> OH, I KNOW THIS -- IT'S A VERY TINY ONE. >> YES. >> I'LL GET BACK TO YOU. >> PROBE GOB'S KNOB OR SOMETHING LIKE THAT. MORE CARROT THAN ANYTHING ELSE. >> IT'S A VERY TINY TOWN. >> OKAY.>> SO THE MONEY COMES IN THE FORM OF A FORMULA GRANT. SO EACH -- SO AND THE FORMULA GRANT IS SET BY STATE BUDGET. SO CURRENTLY, THE FORMULA GRANT IS \$12th PER ELDER, PER YEAR.

BASED ON THE 2010 CENSUS DATA. SO IN 2010 WE HAD 88,70 PEOPLE OVER 60 IN THE CITY. >> I'M SORRY, SAY THAT NUMBER AGAIN. >> 88,070 PEOPLE OVER 60 IN THE 2010 CENSUS. SO YOU TAKE THAT NUMBER AND MULTIPLE APPLY IT BY 12 TO GET OUR FORMULA AMOUNT. SO THAT'S WHROO THIS REPRESENTS. -- WHAT THIS REPRESENTS. THAT MONEY WE KEEP IT INTERNALLY, ALLOWS US TO DO MANY OF THE THINGS OUT IN THE COMMUNITY. WE HAVE COMMUNITY ADVOCATES, ASSIGNED TO EACH NEIGHBORHOOD. THROUGH THE SHINE PROGRAM, HELPING PEOPLE ACCESS INFORMATION AND RESOURCES, DOING **BENEFITS APPLICATIONS, GOING OUT** AND MEETING OLDER ADULTS AND CAREGIVERS WHERE THEY'RE AT AND HELPING THEM FIGURE OUT HOW TO GET ASSISTANCE. THEY ARE PAID FOR OUT OF THIS MONEY. A BIG PORTION OF THEIR SALARY IS PAID OUT OF THIS MONEY. WE ALSO HAVE OUR HOUSING TEAM THAT IS PAID FOR PRIMARILY OUT OF COUNCIL AND AGING DOLLARS. SO AS WE'VE GOTTEN SOME INCREASES OVER THE LAST COUPLE EVER YEARS ON COUNCIL ON AGING WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO DEVELOP A HOUSING TEAM.OF FIVE PEOPLE. ONE OF THOSE PEOPLE IS PAID FOR OUT OF OPERATING BUDGET AND WE REALLY APPRECIATE THE COUNCIL FOR THAT ADDITION LAST YEAR IN OUR OPERATING BUDGET BUT THE REST OF THE TEAM IS PAY FOR OUT OF COUNCIL ON AGING DOLLARS. WE ALSO PAY FOR BOSTON SENIORITY AGING MANAGES OUT OF THIS BUDGET. WE PRINT 15,000 COPIES OF MAGAZINE EVERY MONTH AND HAVE AN ONLINE FOLLOWING OF OVER A THOUSAND PEOPLE. >> GREAT. >> AND THAT IS ALL DONE OUT OF

COUNCIL ON AGING MONEY. ANOTHER BIG THING WE DO, IF WE HAVE SALARY SAVINGS TOWARDS THE END OF THE YEAR WE HAVE BEEN USING THOSE DOLLARS TO PAY FOR ACCESSIBLE VEHICLES FOR OUR SENIOR SHUTTLE. SO IT IS OUR GOAL TO REPLACE ALL OF OUR SHUTTLES THAT ARE NOT ACCESSIBLE WITH SHUMENTS THAT HAVE A LIFT AND OLOWER STEP SO THAT PEOPLE CAN GET MORE EASILY ON THEM. WE ARE ABOUT 70% THE WAY THROUGH OR FLEET NOW THANKS IN PART TO COUNCIL ON AGING DOLLARS. WE DO A LAT OF THINGS ACKNOWLEDGE THIS IS ONE OF OUR MOST FLEXIBLE POTS OF MONEY WHICH MAKES IT A GREAT RESOURCE. >> THAT'S FANTASTIC. 88,070 RESIDENTS THAT BE 60-PLUS AS OF 2010. ANY GUESS OF WHAT THOSE NUMBERS ARE GOING TO BE AT THE 2020 CENSUS? SIGNIFICANTLY MORE. >> IT IS GOING TO BE SIGNIFICANTLY DIFFERENT. THE LAST DATA I HAVE IS FROM 2017. AND THE ESTIMATE AT THAT POINT WAS CLOSE TO 105.000. >> I CAN THINK OF TWO PEOPLE I'M **OUITE CLOSE TO WHO WERE NOT 60** BLUES IN 2010, BUT ARE SO NOW. I WOULD VENTURE WE GET CLOSER TO 120 JUST AS THE CITY GROWS AND PEOPLE STAY AND AGE IN PLACE. WHICH NEIGHBORHOOD HAS THE HIGHEST PERCENTAGE OF SENIORS? >> YOU KNOW THE ANSWER TO THIS COUNCILOR. WEST ROXBURY. >> DE LOS TO A QUARTER OF WEST ROXBURY RESIDENTS. >> CLOSE TO 25%. >> I THINK WE SHOULD LOBBY OUR LEGISLATURE TO UP THAT AMOUNT. THAT SEEMS KIND OF LOW, RIGHT? >> YOU KNOW I THINK -->> I WON'T PUT YOU ON THE SPOT, EDDIE AND I CAN DO THAT LOBBYING.

ANYTHING IS GREAT FOR SENIORS. HOUSING, SENIOR SHUTTLES, BOSTON SENIORITY, I LOOK FORWARD TO READING. SO MANY GREAT PROGRAMS. THAT'S GREAT. I HAVE NO FURTHER QUESTIONS ON DOCKET 0217, COUNSELOR FLYNN. >> NO. >> MESSAGE AND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND THE AMOUNT OF \$1,860,000 IN IN THE FORM OF A GRANT, TO BE ADMINISTERED BY AGE STRONG BOSTON. >> THIS IS AGAIN, THIS IS PASS-THROUGH MONEY FOR US. >> OKAY.>> THIS IS STATE DOLLARS, AND WHAT THE NUMBER THAT YOU SEE IS THE AMOUNT OF LAST YEAR'S GRANT PLUS A BUFFER, IN CASE THE AMOUNT CHANGES BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR SO THAT WE DON'T HAVE TO COME BACK IN HERE TO YOU. AND THIS MONEY HELPS FUND NUTRITION PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF BOSTON. SO THIS IS ANOTHER PROGRAM THAT WE PUT OUT TO BID. WE HAVE TWO GRANTEES THAT **OPERATE THIS PROGRAM IN THE** CITY. ONE IS ETHOS AND THE OTHER ONE IS CHINESE SCHOOL MAID CENTER. AND TOGETHER THEY ARE DOING BOTH HOME DELIVERED MEALS SO IF THERE IS AN OLDER ADULT IN THIS CITY WHO CANNOT GET OUT AND WHO NEEDS A HOME-DELIVERED MEAL THEY'RE PROVIDING THAT MEAL TO THEM. BRINGING IT TO THEIR DOOR. THEY ALSO ARE OPERATING A TOTAL OF 47 CAFES OR CONGREGATE MEAL SITES ACROSS THE CITY WHERE PEOPLE OVER 60 CAN COME AND GET A MEAL FOR FREE, WITH A SUGGESTED DONATION OF \$2. AND SO AS THIS IS A VERY IMPORTANT PROGRAM IN OUR CITY. THIS IS ALL -- THESE ARE ALL PASS-THROUGH DOLLARS FOR US. SO WE DON'T KEEP ANY OF THE IT -- OF IT. WE PASS IT THROUGH.

THESE ARE ONE OF THE THREE COMPONENTS OF NUTRITION FUDGED THAT COME TO OUR OFFICE THEN WE GIVE OUT TO PEOPLE IN ETHOS AROUND -->> CHINESE MAID I BELIEVE -->> CHINESE GOLD NEEDS CENTER DOES PRIMARY AROUND THE CHINATOWN AREA. I WOULD SAY. BUT THEIR CONTRACT IS FOR CHINESE MEALS THROUGHOUT THE CITY. SO THEY DO DELIVER HOME DELIVERED MEALS MORE BROADLY. THEIR CAFES THAT THEY RUN ARE PRIMARILY CENTERED AROUND THE UP CHOINT, DOWNTOWN AREA. >> THAT'S GREAT. 80-20 PLIT SOME 90 -- 80-20 SPLIT, 90-20? >> I DIDN'T BRING THOSE NUMBERS. >> JUST LET US KNOW BEFORE WE TAKE ACTION NEXT WEEK. MORE CURIOUS THAN ANYTHING. THIS MONEY HELPS TO PROVIDE SOME OF THOSE WONDERFUL CULTURALLY APPROPRIATE DINING CENTERS. >> CORRECT. >> I KNOW THEY DO A SPECIFIC FOOD, THEY DO AN LGBT CAFE FOR OLDER ADULTS. TALK ABOUT THAT. >> SO THERE ARE ALL DIFFERENT TYPES OF DINING CENTERS, ALL DIFFERENT TIMES OF THE WEEK. SOME RUN IN THE EVENING, SOME ON THE WEEKENDS, THEY REALLY TRY THE MEET THE NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY. WE HAVE FIVE I BELIEVE LGBT FRIENDLY LUNCH SITES THAT ETHOS RUNS WHICH ARE FANTASTIC SITES, LUNCH, DINNER, WEEKENDS, THEY SPREAD THE GAMUT THERE. WE HAVE OUR CHINESE SITES AND THEN WE HAVE OTHER SITES WHERE OUR NUTRITION VENDORS, ETHOS CONTRACTS WITH VENDORS LIKE CITY FRESH AND FAIR FOODS, EMILY'S FAIR FOODS. SO THOSE VENDORS ARE ABLE TO DO MORE CULTURALLY SPECIFIC MEALS AND SOME OF THOSE ARE SERVED AT THE LUNCH SITES.

DEPENDING ON THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND THE POPULATION THEY SERVE. >> ARE THAT'S GREAT. COMMISSIONER. I AM COMPELLED TO ASK YOU SOME REALLY TOUGH OUESTIONS HERE AT THIS HEARING MANY HERE GOES, I KNOW YOU HAVE VISITED MANY OF THESE SITES, WHAT IS YOUR FAVORITE CAFE TO GO TO? YOU HAVE TO ANSWER. >> I REFUSE TO ANSWER COUNCILOR. THEY ARE ALL GREAT SITES AND UNIQUE, DEPENDING WHO GOES THERE AND WHAT OTHER THINGS ARE GOING ON AT THAT SITE. >> FAIR ENOUGH. COUNSELOR FLYNN. >> THANK YOU, COUNCILOR O' O'MALLEY. I WANT TO ADD I FREQUENTLY GO TO THE CHINESE SCHOOL AND AID CENTER, AND I HAVE AN **OPPORTUNITY TO TALK TO THE RESIDENTS THAT ARE HAVING LUNCH** THERE. AND I CAN TELL YOU FROM FIRSTHAND EXPERIENCE THAT THE LUNCHES ARE EXCELLENT. THE -- IT'S PREPARED WELL. AND SEEING THE ENJOYMENT FROM MY CONSTITUENTS, BUT FROM EVERYONE'S CONSTITUENTS, REALLY, HOW IMPORTANT A NUTRITIONAL LUNCH IS. **IS VERY -- IS VERY** COMPASSIONATE. IS VERY GOOD FOR OUR CITY, IT IS VERY GOOD FOR OUR ELDERLY COMMUNITY. SO THEY APPRECIATE ALL YOUR EFFORTS AND HARD WORK. IT'S A GREAT PROGRAM AND I'LL BE GLAD TO SUPPORT THIS AND ALL YOUR PROGRAMS AS WELL. BUT THANK YOU, COMMISSIONER. >> I JUST HAVE ONE THANK YOU, COUNSELOR FLYNN, ONE FINAL OUESTION ON DOCKET 0220. WE HAD EXPLAINED, OR I DON'T KNOW IF WE DID IT WHILE WE WERE RECORDING SO I'LL DO IT NOW, THAT TWO OF THE FIGURES ARE DIFFERENT THAN ORIGINALLY LISTED.

THE FIRST WAS DOCKET 0335 WAS **ORIGINALLY -- PUBLICLY NOTICED** AS \$171,242. IT ACTUALLY WAS \$214,000, I BELIEVE THAT'S REFLECTING THE BUFFER OF 25%. >> THAT'S ON DOCKET 110. YES. >> I'M SORRY, THAT'S THE BUFFER. SO DOCKET 0220 WAS ORIGINALLY NOTICED OR PUBLIC REPLY NOTICED AT \$124,263.36. IT'S ACTUALLY \$1.8 MILLION. SO WHY SUCH A LARGE DISCREPANCY? >> SO I'M NOT EXACT REPLY SURE HOW THE \$124,000 GOT IN THERE. WE'RE WORK ON FIGURING THAT OUT. OUR AMOUNT FROM LAST YEAR IS AROUND VERY CLOSE TO 1.5 MILLION SO IT IS \$1.5 MILLION PLUS A SMALL BUFFER IN CASE WE PUT A **25% BUFFER ON IN CASE THINGS** CHANGE TOWARDS THE END OF THE YEAR. >> THIS SEEMS TO ME IT WAS A CLERICAL ERROR. WAIT, WHAT DID YOU SAY IT WAS LAST YEAR? >> IT WAS -- YOU WANT THE EXACT AMOUNT? >> YES. >>> 1,488,127.68. >> OKAY, I HAD WONDERED IF MAYBE A FIGURE, IF IT WAS 1.24 MILLION IF A FIGURE HAD DROPPED.OFF. BUT SUFFICE IT TO SAY THE FIRST ONE WE DIDN'T -- THE FIRST NUMERICAL ERROR BETWEEN WHAT WAS POSTED AND WHAT WE WILL VOTE ON IS IT DIDN'T COUNT FOR THE 25% SORT OF CONTINGENCY. BUT THIS ONE WAS AN ERROR. WE WILL BE VOTING ON THE FULL AMOUNT, \$1.056 -- \$1,860,000. ALL THESE DOCKETS, MAYBE THAT'S THE ISSUE. \$1,860,000. EVEN. IS WHAT L DOCKET 0220'S CORRECT AMOUNT IS. >> YES AND OF COURSE WE WILL SPEND UP TO OUR CONTRACTED AMOUNT. >> CARET. IF WE DON'T HIT THE BUFFER DO WE

GET TO KEEP IT OR DOES IT HAVE TO GO BACK? >> IF WE DON'T GET UP TO THE **BUFFER**? >> YES. >> IF WE -- IF WE GO BEYOND THE BUFFER WE'LL HAVE TO COME BACK TO YOU. BUT WHAT WE'LL SPEND IS EXACTLY WHAT OUR CONTRACTED AMOUNT IS. >> OKAY GOOD. FINALISTLY FOR AGE STRONG DOCKET 0335. A MESSAGE AND ORDER. AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND DEPEND THE AMOUNT OF \$400,000 FOR A GRANT FOR THE NUTRITION SERVICES INCENTIVE GRANT AWARDED BY THE UFS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, PASSED THROUGH THE MASS OFFICE OF EXECUTIVE AFFAIRS TO BE ADMINISTERED BY AGE STRONG BOSTON. >> YES. SO THIS IS ACTUALLY VERY SIMILAR TO THE STATE ELDER LUNCH PROGRAM THAT WE JUST TALKED ABOUT, EXCEPT IT IS A FEDERAL FORCE OF NUTRITIONAL FUNDING. THE INCENTIVE PROGRAM COMES TO **US THROUGH THE FEDERAL** GOVERNMENT, AND THIS IS, AGAIN, A PASS THROUGH GRANT TO US, IT'S A PASS-THROUGH GRANT FOR US, IT IS ONE OF THE THREE SOURCES OF NUTRITION FUNDING THAT KIND OF COMBINE TOGETHER TO MAKE THE FULL PACKAGE. >> OKAY.AND DO WE -- WHO IS OUR VENDOR WITH THIS? IS IT ETHOS AGAIN? >> SO WE GO OUT TO BID FOR THE ENTIRE PROGRAM. >> YEP. >> EVEN THOUGH WE'RE VOTING ON SPECIFIC FUNDING SOURCES WE GO OUT TO BID FOR THE ENTIRE PACKAGE. >> I SEE. IS THIS CONSISTENT OR GREATER? >> WE DIDN'T PUT A BUFFER, THIS NEVER GOES UP. THIS HAS BEEN LEVEL FUNDED FOR A

SIGNIFICANTLY LONG TIME. >> OKAY.IS THIS -- WHEN YOU HEAR ABOUT FEDERAL CUTS BEING PROPOSED TO MEALS ON WHEELS, FOR EXAMPLE, IS THAT HOW -- WOULD THIS MONEY BE USED FOR I ASSUME THE DELIVERY SERVICE LIKE MEALS ON WHEELS WILLIAM. >> THIS MONEY IS USED FOR MEALS ON WHEELS. IT IS ONE OF THE SMALLER PORTIONS OF OUR FUNDING. >> I SEE. >> AND IT HAS BEEN RELATIVELY STABLE AROUND HASN'T REALLY GONE UP OR DOWN FOR A LONG TIME. >> OKAY, IF IT'S NOT GOING DOWN. OKAY. ANY QUESTIONS ON THAT? THANK YOU, COUNSELOR FLYNN. WE ARE DONE WITH YOU. TIMELY MS. CHANG, 0336, A MESSAGE AND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO EXPEND THE SUCH \$200,000 EVEN, FOR THE IMMIGRANT GRANT INITIATIVE, AWARDED TO THE DONOR GROUP, TELL US ABOUT DOCKET 336. >> THIS IS A SELECTABLE POOL OF MONEY THAT WE RAISED. >> THE WE ARE BOSTON GALA AND REALLY ALLOWS OUR OFFICE TO SUPPORT MANY OF THE GRASS ROOTS AND I NENT GRASS ROOTS. IMMIGRANTS-LED, IMMIGRANT-SERVED ORGANIZATIONS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, TO EXPAND THEIR POLICEMAN CAPACITY TO SERVE THE DIVERSE COMMUNITIES IN THE CITY, AND ALSO TO SUPPORT SOME OF THE PROGRAMMING THAT ARE KIND OF NOT THE SUM OF THE OTHER INSTALL ORGANIZATIONS, PROVIDING DIRECT SERVICES THAT THEY ARE PROVIDING TO THE IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES ALL OVER THE CITY OF BOSTON. >> GREAT. SO THIS IS MONEY THAT WAS RAISED AT THE WE ARE BOSTON GALA? >> CORRECT. AND THE DONOR GROUP IS THAT AN ACTUAL GROUP OR WE TALKING ABOUT -->> 0 IT'S ALL CONTRIBUTORS AND

SUPPORTERS OF OUR OFFICE. SO MANY OF THEM ARE THE CORPORATE LEADERS. THEY ARE ALSO SOME OF THE COMMUNITY LEADERS. >> EXCELLENT. >> FROM THE CITY AND BEYOND AS WELL. >> IT'S ALWAYS A WONDERFUL EVEN, DOGS PARTICULARLY WHERE IMPORTANT WORK AT THIS TIME IN OUR COUNTRY. I'VE BEEN SO IMPRESSED WITH YOUR LEADERSHIP, WITH YOUR COLLEAGUES LEADERSHIP AND WITH MAYOR WALSH'S LEADERSHIP. WHY ALL OF OUR FAMILIES WERE IMMIGRANTS, MOST OF WHOM ARE IMMIGRANTS TO THIS COUNTRY, MAKE SURE ALL BOSTONIANS, WHETHER THEY ARE DOCUMENTED OR NONDOCUMENTED KNOW THAT WE SEE THEM, WE VALUE THEM AND WE ARE GOING TO PROTECT THEM. I REALLY APPRECIATE THE CRUCIAL WORK YOU ARE DOING. FOUR YEARS AGO I DON'T THINK WE APPRECIATED THE GRAVITY OF HAVING AN OFFICE, I BELIEVE IT WAS CALLED OFFICE OF NEW BOSTONIANS WHEN I FIRST JOINED THE COUNCIL AND I ALSO APPRECIATE MAYOR MENINO AND MAYOR WALSH FOR HIS CONTINUED LEADERSHIP. ALL OF THESE GRANTS ARE NO BRAINERS. WE WILL BE VOTING FAVORABLY FOR THEM. I REALLY APPRECIATE THE WORK THAT YOU UP ALL ARE DOING AND --THAT YOU ALL ARE DOING AND THE NECESSITY OF THE WORK IN THIS DAY AND ABLE. I HAVE NO FURTHER QUESTIONS FOR YOU. COUNSELOR FLYNN. >> THANK YOU, COUNCILOR O'MALLEY. THANK YOU FOR BEING HERE AND THANK YOU FOR YOUR GREAT WORK ON BEHALF OF OUR **IMMIGRANT COMMUNITY HERE IN** BOSTON. I'LL BE VERY BRIEF BUT I WANT TO ECHO WHAT COUNCILOR O'MALLEY

SAID.

I'M ALSO PROUD TO REPRESENT A LARGE IMMIGRANT POPULATION, **COMMUNITY HERE IN DISTRICT 2 INCLUDING A LARGE CHINESE** COMMUNITY. I'M PROUD TO REPRESENT THEM. BUT MORE IMPORTANTLY, I'M PROUD OF THEIR OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS THAT THEY'VE MADE TO OUR CITY AND TO OUR COUNTRY. I'M WORKING WITH THE CITY OF BOSTON DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH ON A FORUM IN CHOINT ON PUBLIC HEALTH RELATED ISSUES. SOMETIME OVER THE NEXT TWO OR THREE MONTHS. AND WE JUST WANT TO PROVIDE AS MUCH INFORMATION AS WE CAN, TO THE CHINATOWN COMMUNITY ABOUT WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE TO THEM, IN HOW THEY CAN ACCESS VARIOUS SERVICES, VARIOUS PROGRAMS. SO I'LL KEEP YOUR OFFICE INFORMED ABOUT THIS EVENT AND I KNOW WE'RE WORKING WITH COMMISSIONER SHAY AS WELL AND OTHER CITY DEPARTMENTS. BUT MAYBE OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF WEEKS IF YOU HAVE SOME TIME I CAN PROVIDE A BETTER UPDATE ON WHAT WE'RE LOOKING AT. BUT JUST WANT TO SAY THANK YOU FOR YOUR OUTSTANDING WORK AND ALWAYS ENSURING THAT OUR IMMIGRANT COMMUNITY IS TREATED WITH RESPECT AND TREATED WITH DIGNITY. AND AS MATT MENTIONED WE'RE ALSO PROUD OF MAYOR WALSH FOR THE WELCOMING CITY THAT BOSTON IS TO IMMIGRANTS. >> THANK YOU, COUNCILOR O'MALLEY AND COUNSELOR FLYNN. AT THIS TIME IT'S BEEN CHALLENGING, TO MY TEAM, TWO OF THEM ARE HERE. BUT WE CONTINUE ON WITH YOUR SUPPORT AND WITH THE MAYOR'S SUPPORT, REALLY APPRECIATE IT, THANK YOU SO MUCH. >> THANK YOU ALL. I HAVE NO FURTHER COMMENTS.

DOES ANY OF YOU HAVE ANY CLOSING **REMARKS**? SPEAK NOW OR FOREVER HOLD YOUR PEACE. THIS IS A PUBLIC HEARING. IF ANYONE WOULD LIKE TO TESTIFY. THEY ARE WELCOME TO DO SO. I SEE NO TAKERS. ONCE AGAIN, I APPRECIATE THIS. WE -- YOU KNOW FOR THOSE WHO MAY BE WATCHING THIS AT HOME. ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT **OVERSIGHT ROLES OF THE COUNCIL** IS TO DISCUSS EVERY PENNY THAT IS SPENT THROUGH CITY'S COFFERS. WE OFTEN THIS THESE EVENTS THAT ARE NONCONTROVERSIAL, BUT I APPRECIATE HEARING WHAT YOU AS TEAMS ARE DOING AND WE AS A CITY ARE DOING. AT THE NEXT COUNCIL MEETING I WILL BE FAVORABLY REPORTING ON 0109, 0110, DID I HIT THEM ALL?
